Charoen Pokphand Foods (CPF TB)

Neutral (from Buy)

Waiting For Stimulating Catalysts; D/G To NEUTRAL

Target Price (Return): THB21 (7.7%) Price (Market Cap): THB19.50 (USD4,540m) ESG score: 3.4 (out of 4) Avg Daily Turnover (THB/USD) 314m/9.03m

- Downgrade to NEUTRAL from Buy, new THB21 TP from THB24, 8% upside, c.1% FY23F yield. While Charoen Pokphand Foods should benefit from the ongoing consumption recovery, it is still dealing with high raw material costs. Despite some cheaper raw material price trends expected for 2H23, swine prices have dropped due to increased supply. Hence, we adjust margins downwards. The share price is now inexpensive, but it may take some time for CPF to see strong catalysts, eg a continuous recovery in swine prices.
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


Lower losses than expected, better than market and our estimates. CPF posted a 2Q23 net loss of THB792m, mainly on seasonally higher demand, strong chicken prices, investment sales, and lower-than-expected raw material costs. Revenue rose 4% QoQ (-4% YoY) to THB150bn on seasonal demand while GPM was better than expected at 11% (1Q23: 10.8%). Thai swine prices dropped to c.THB72.5/kg from 1Q23's THB85/kg while CPF's swine business in China showed a weaker performance - this is in relation to lower swine prices there (from CNY15.20/kg previously to CNY14.30/kg), which resulted in a THB0.9bn loss in terms of equity income. However, the Vietnam swine business is recovering, with prices moving to VND55,000/kg from VND50,000/kg previously. Chicken prices remain high at THB43/kg (1Q23: THB40/kg). Corn raw material prices were down to THB11.40/kg from the prior THB13/kg.

• 2H23 to be better. Management believes raw material costs should be lower in 2H23. Major raw material prices - eg corn and soybean - are expected to be lower on increased supply due to better harvests in North and South America. CPF said it can also manage costs by mixing wheat with corn. It also believes that, while Thai swine price will take time to recover, chicken prices should be better as the company enter 3Q23's high season. CPF also thinks volumes will likely to increase from increased distribution into modern trade channels.



Lower 2023 margins. Swine prices in Thailand are moving downwards – they fell to THB60/kg in 2Q23 from THB72.50/kg due to high supply, especially from smuggled pork that is illegally stored in domestic cold storage facilities. Therefore, CPF's 2023 margins could fall to 11.5% from our earlier estimate of 11.8% – this is in view of the higher swine supply and difficulties in agricultural transportation due to the Russia-Ukraine conflict.

• ESG: Inexpensive valuations but lack near-term catalysts. With CPF's 3.4 ESG score – and with the country median now at 3.2 – our TP, which is near an average of 0.9x P/BV, is revised to THB21. This is inclusive of a 4% ESG premium. The company's valuation is inexpensive – it is trading at 0.8x P/BV vs the 5-year historical level of 1.05x. However, CPF lacks catalysts at this time. Therefore, we change our call to NEUTRAL.

Overall ESG Score: 3.4 (out of 4)

E: GOOD

CPF aims to support environmental products and has a strong policy of supporting environment-friendly suppliers. All its plants comply with environmental and waste treatment standards.

S: EXCELLENT

Being reliant on agricultural labour, CPF has the highest exposure to this ESG pillar. However, it has managed its social and community relationships well. The company has a strong policy of not supporting labour malpractices. CPF also applies international standards - as per those specified by Dow Jones Sustainability Indices and United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. It also conducts its social responsibility activities based on engaging in projects that are suitable for society needs.

G: EXCELLENT

CPF follows the guidance of the Thai Institute of Directors. Its disclosure policy is in compliance with regulations set by the SET. As it is a listed company, CPF also discloses and promptly important information broadly stakeholders.


