## AP (Thailand) (AP TB)

**Buy** (Maintained)

### 3Q23 Earnings Growth Against Industry Trend

Target Price (Return): THB14.70 (32.4%)  
 Price (Market Cap): THB11.1 (USD981m)  
 ESG score: 2.9 (out of 4)  
 Avg Daily Turnover (THB/USD) 106m/2.95m

- **Maintain BUY and THB14.70 TP, 32% upside with c.6% yield.** AP (Thailand) recorded 3Q23 earnings growth, as expected. The pure-play developer should be the best candidate to mark earnings growth for FY23, against the industry trend.
- **3Q23 earnings in line.** AP announced 3Q23 net profit of THB1.69bn (+20% YoY, +10% QoQ) – slightly (1%) above our estimates. 3Q23 core revenue of THB10.1bn (+12% YoY, +8% QoQ) also met our estimates as project sales revenue was dominated by single detached houses (SDH) under its “The City” brand and its newly completed “Aspire Pinklao Arun Amarin” condominium project. 3Q23 overall GPM of 35.5% was lower QoQ as high-margin SDH projects – especially The City Bangna – had a smaller role in commanding revenue during the quarter. There was also a higher revenue portion from newly completed condominiums with lower-than-average GPM. Lower finance costs and stringent controls on SG&A expenses also supported 3Q23 earnings growth.
- **Post 3Q23,** we note that AP was able to manage its earnings momentum vs its large peers. Its actual 9M23 net profit was flat YoY at THB4.7bn while the majority of large developers will report a decline in 3Q23 earnings. While AP’s 9M23 core revenue declined 3% YoY and finance costs surged 247%YoY, the GPM improvement from 33.6% in 9M22 to 36.5% in 9M23 can offset these negative impacts. In 9M23, sales revenue from the condominium segment rose 15% YoY, while low-rise projects saw a 5% YoY decline in sales revenue.
- **Based on the flat YoY earnings for 9M23,** 4Q23 performance will be the critical factor to determine AP’s full-year earnings growth. For FY23, pure-play developers are unlikely to post core profit growth from project sales. However, AP is expected to maximise its efforts to realise revenue from its abundant orderbooks in the low-rise project segment to go against the industry trend. We expect AP’s 4Q23 earnings to decline QoQ but grow YoY to record earnings growth for FY23.
- **FY23 targets.** While we expect FY23 earnings growth for AP, the company may miss a few business targets, including its presales target (THB58bn) and new project launch target (THB77bn). Based on its actual 10M23 presales of THB38.9bn (-14.4% YoY), it seems unlikely for AP to achieve its full-year target. However, management appears confident of boosting FY23 presales to be on par with FY22’s actual presales of THB50.4bn. AP will also be more aggressive with new project launches in 4Q23 (THB35.7bn project value), helping it approach its FY23 target.
- **ESG.** Our TP includes a 6% ESG discount, given AP’s ESG score of 2.9 (below the country median), and is based on 7.25x P/E. A low prospective P/E implies our conservative view on price competition among developers going forward.

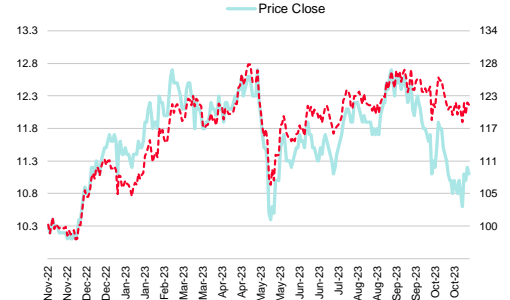

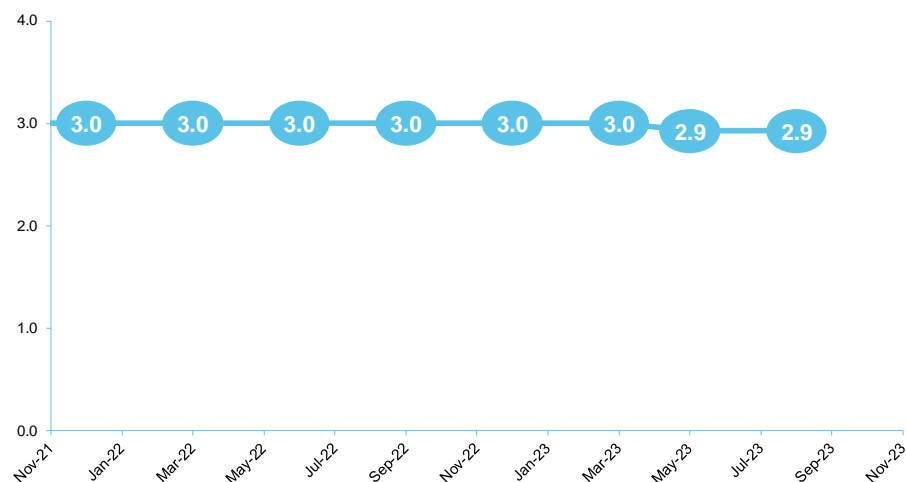
