Weaker-Than-Expected 3Q22 Numbers; Still BUY

Target Price (Return): THB31.50 (18%)
 Price (Market Cap): THB26.75 (USD2,180m)

- **Still BUY, new THB31.50 TP from THB33, 18% upside and c.3% yield.** Osotspa's 3Q22 net profit was below our and Street's forecasts, mainly due to cost hikes that undermined GPM and the opex-to-sales ratio. We retain the view that OSP's share price has reflected the bottomed out 3Q22 bottomline – it still deserves long-term investments, as the energy drink leader's premiumisation strategy may be accepted by 2023.
- **Sluggish 3Q22 results.** OSP posted a 3Q22 net profit of THB244m (-58% YoY, -60% QoQ) – its weakest quarter since 4Q18's listing. This was materially below our forecast of THB390m and c.20% less than Street's estimates due to lower-than-expected GPM and opex hikes. Total sales stood at THB6.28bn (+1% YoY, -14% QoQ). Aside from 3Q's low season, sales contributions for personal care, international businesses, and other segments stood at 10%, c.19%, and 12%. This strong YoY growth delivery was partially offset by the decline in the local beverages segment during the premiumisation transition period for M-150 energy drinks. GPM stood at 29.3% (-4.2ppts YoY, -1.9ppts QoQ) on raw material costs hikes (natural gas and aluminium sheets) and fixed cost deleveraging from lower volumes at both OSP's glass and beverage factories. The opex-to-sales ratio ramped up 2.9ppts YoY (+3.4ppts QoQ) to 26.4% on advertising & promotional expenses related to M-150's new product launches and C-vitt's campaigns, as well as FX losses with regards to the mark-to-market USD-denominated loans for the Myanmar operations. Consequently, 9M22 earnings totalled THB1.60bn, down 34% YoY.
- **Seeks a 4Q22 recovery.** OSP has remained the domestic market leader in both energy and functional drinks. It recorded 9M22 market shares of 50.3% (energy) and 43.6% (functional) for such drinks. Market share has stabilised with expectations of continued recovery from 4Q22 onwards. We expect earnings to bottom out in 3Q22. We also think improving sales volumes from traditional trade retail channels, production efficiencies, and opex controls will lead to QoQ topline and profit margin rebounds in 4Q. We believe the recent floods in October may only cause short-term slowdowns in inventory orders among retailers, while incremental utilities and personnel expenses (in tandem with inflation) could affect opex by <5%. Higher raw material costs may still see 4Q22F earnings drop YoY.
- **Forecasts cut.** Reflecting the weak performance, we lower 2022F and 2023F-2024F earnings by 13% and 8% – mainly on cuts in GPM assumptions by another 0.5ppts (2022) and 0.25ppts over the next two years with the opex-to-sales ratio rising 0.5-0.8ppts over the 3-year period. We expect core earnings of THB2.09bn (-36%) in 2022 before turning to a 30% growth to THB2.72bn in 2023.
- **Valuation.** We maintain an ESG score of 3.5 and apply a 4% premium to our DCF-derived intrinsic value to arrive at a new THB31.50 TP for a 12-month investment horizon. OSP's current 29x FY23F P/E (c.-0.5SD) still makes its valuation undemanding – it deserves long-term investment.

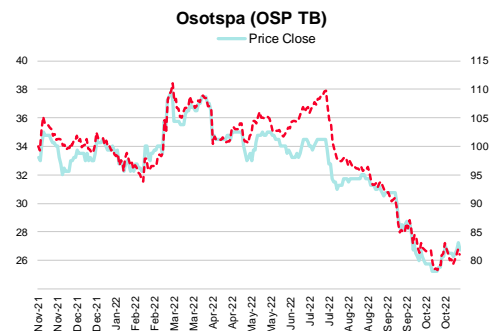

Recommendation Chart

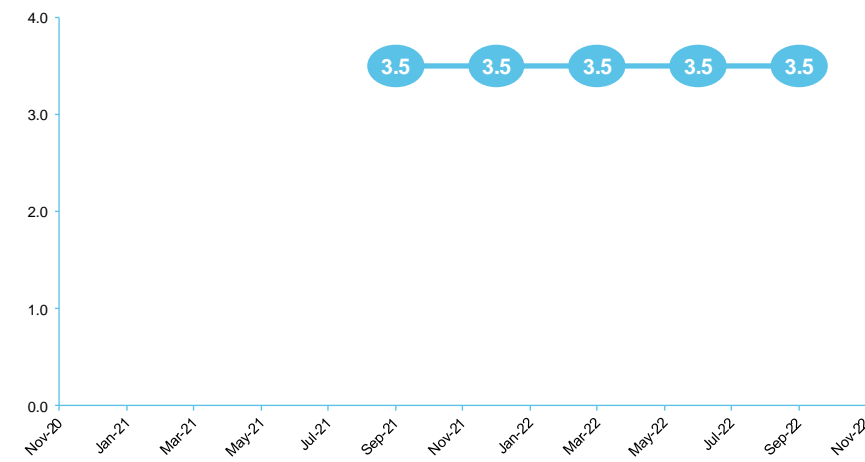
