

Keep BUY, slightly lower THB32.20 DCF-based TP from THB34.40 (due to ESG score update), 7% upside, c.2% yield. TOA Paint's earnings remained under pressure in FY21-22 due to the surge in production costs, despite its core revenue seeing an uptrend throughout the period. However, its strong 1Q23 performance should mark the resumption of earnings growth for the company.

Signs Of a Resumption Of Growth; Keep BUY

- Brighter prospects ahead. From TOA's 1Q23 earnings (+54% YoY, +120% QoQ), there were three positive signs for its prospects going forward: i) Sales volume growth played a bigger role in driving sales revenue to a new record high, as the decorative paint segment's 1Q23 sales volumes rose +8% YoY, ii) GPM improved strongly to 32.9% in 1Q23 from <30% throughout FY22, from a higher sales revenue proportion for premium-grade products, given the aggressive advertising campaigns for these products in FY22, and iii) stricter controls on SG&A expenses (18.4% of 1Q23 sales revenue vs 20% in previous quarters) compared to the high number of FY22 marketing activities. The only disappointment in 1Q23 was its Vietnam operations, which saw a steep decline in sales revenue (-21% YoY, -33% QoQ) due to a slowdown in the local real estate market. However, the impact from its Vietnam operations was limited, accounting for only 5-6% of TOA's 1Q23 sales revenue.
- Earnings growth to resume in FY23. After its earnings were hit by the surge in production costs in the past two years, we expect TOA to handle cost management more effectively this year. Although the upward revision of average product prices has been discontinued YTD, and revenue growth prospects will rely heavily on sales volumes, the company assured this year's earnings growth will be supported by stronger revenue from both the decorative and non-decorative paint products, especially via the modern trade channel (+28% YoY in 1Q23) - with the bulk of production from the high-margin segment. Note that management aims for an FY23 sales revenue growth of +15% YoY, while we expect a more conservative +11% YoY. The impact of average product price revisions is fading, and sales volume growth will resume its critical role. We also expect TOA to benefit from the softer energy and raw material costs. We expect its GPM (improved YTD, rose above 30%) uptrend to continue as major raw materials prices except titanium dioxide have fallen YoY.
- ESG framework update. As there is now greater focus on the E pillar due to critical climate change issues, we tweak our ESG weightage, assigning 50% to the E pillar, followed by 25% each to the S and G pillars. For more details, see our 2 May thematic research note *Envisioning a Better Future*. Our ESG score is revised to 2.5 from 2.9. As our country median is now 3.2 from 3.3, our TP falls to THB32.20 with a 14% ESG discount.


Figure 1: Stronger sales revenue across all product segments including decorative and non-decorative Figure 2: Modern trade channel outperformed other sales channels with double-digit sales revenue growth

Recommendation Chart


