Thai Union Group (TU TB)

Strong Pet Food Line, Plant Modernisation; BUY

- Keep BUY and THB22 TP, 49% upside and c.5% FY23F yield. Thai Union is on its way towards enhancing its pet food business via it I-Tail Corp (ITC TB, NR) subsidiary, and strong modernisation and sanitary conditions of its plants. We are positive on the group's long-term prospects, in view of the
- recoveries in domestic and global consumption. Tuna raw material costs are also under control. We think FY23F earnings will be supported by the pet care market and frozen seafood segment's recoveries post relaxation of global COVID-19 measures. TU also offers strong yields for investors.
- Still sticking with Red Lobster. Management has denied rumours about divesting Red Lobster, given recent news flows about TU's food chain associate. TU said this business was still undergoing a monitoring process. In our view, even if Red Lobster cannot post an operating performance recovery and is divested any positives may only occur in the long term. In the short term, there may be one-time extra losses from a divestment. In the long run, we believe TU will gain positives, as it will no longer need to recognise Red Lobster losses of c.THB500-1,000m pa, which contributes c.8-14% of the company's bottomline. We do not think the process will reach this point, as TU still sees Red Lobster gaining benefits from better frozen food demand and food service & hotel industries or HORECA consumption in 2023. We think the frozen seafood business is set to improve following the relaxation of global COVID-19 measures. We also expect gross margins to remain high at c.18%, enhanced by the pet food unit. Transportation costs are likely to improve too on reduced congestion vis-à-vis containers.
- Pet food plant's modernisation. We had the opportunity to visit TU's subsidiary's plant at Samut Sakhon Province recently. ITC's facility is able to adopt many automation systems during its modernisation process on top of its strong hygiene standards. This subsidiary also plans to launch three attractive brands in China: Bellotta, Marvo, and ChangeTer. Management guided that ITC can see high market size growth with a CAGR of 25% and c.15% growth in 2023, ie higher than industry average of 7%. ITC is also building a new production plant in Samut Sakhon, which aims to increase total wet pet food and treats capacities by 18.7% with a new automated packing line. Construction is ongoing, with plans to commercialise within 2Q23.
- ESG, cheap valuation. Based on our proprietary methodology, we derived an ESG score of 3.4 out of 4.0 for TU. Accordingly, we apply a 2% premium to our DCF-intrinsic value to derive our THB22 TP. The P/E ratio is also reduced to 9x in 2023, ie below the 5-year average of 13x. TU is likely to pay attractive dividends, with a c.5% yield estimated for 2023.






