A Better 4Q Ahead; Maintain BUY

Target Price (Return): THB75.50 (27.4%)
 Price (Market Cap): THB59.25 (USD14,498m)
 ESG score: 3.6 (out of 4)
 Avg Daily Turnover (THB/USD) 1,443m/40.9m

- **Still BUY, slightly lower THB75.50 TP (DCF) from THB76, 27% upside and c.2% yield.** We expect CP All's 3Q23F core profit to expand 7% YoY on stronger operations in all its business segments, but decline 9% QoQ on the seasonal impact of its convenience store (CVS) segment to the topline and GPM. Still, we believe 4Q23 could see the strongest quarterly earnings for this year. Valuation is still attractive, given its solid 2023F-2024F growth.
- **All units' SSSG in positive territory.** We assume a 3Q23 CVS SSSG of +2.5% YoY based on the improving momentum in September. Its subsidiary CP Axta's (CPAXT TB, NR) SSSG should continue growing 3% YoY for its Makro wholesale business, while the local and Malaysian retail operations of Lotus's are expected to improve +2% and stay flat YoY respectively during the quarter. SSSG for its CVS and wholesale units may be less than that of 2Q23 due to the YoY high-base effect, as Thai locals resumed outdoor activities after COVID-19 restrictions were lifted in 2Q23.
- **3Q23 preview.** The projected opening of 160 new CVS and three Makro stores during the quarter should help CPALL's total sales grow 5% YoY, although it may dip 4% QoQ on seasonal factors. Average GPM may be flat YoY as CVS operations could see an improving product mix (mainly from high-margin ready-to-eat foods and personal care items). However, there may be price competition in Lotus's retail wing. GPM may decline 0.2ppts QoQ due to a smaller CVS margin. The opex-to-sales ratio could rise by a marginal 0.1ppts YoY (flat QoQ) on expenses related to CVS' annual stamp campaign and Makro's higher online delivery costs. Interest expenses may fall 11% YoY and 8% QoQ thanks to CPAXT's completion of its debt restructuring in April. We therefore expect CPALL to post a 3Q23 core profit of THB4.08bn (+7% YoY, -9% QoQ) as the weakest quarter this year, and forecast CPAXT's 3Q23 core profit at THB1.79bn (+12% YoY, +5% QoQ).
- **A stronger 4Q.** We are optimistic that CPALL's core profit will expand YoY and QoQ in 4Q23F to record the highest quarterly earnings this year, driven by the CVS, Makro, and Lotus's businesses, as it is the high season for retailers. It should also benefit from the electricity price cuts (electricity costs account for c.2% of revenue) and declining interest expenses.

- **Earnings revision.** To reflect our 9M23 forecasts, we lower 2023F-2025F core profits by 3-4%. Our current forecasts still show robust earnings growth of 28% (77% of pre-pandemic levels) and 23% YoY for 2023 and 2024.
- **Valuations.** We applied an 8% ESG premium to the intrinsic value to derive our new DCF-based TP of THB75.50. CPALL is trading at 31x FY23F P/E (slightly below the 5-year historical mean) and 25x FY24 P/E (-1SD), and remains our Thai retail sector Top Pick.
- **Key risks:** Weaker-than-expected consumption and higher opex.

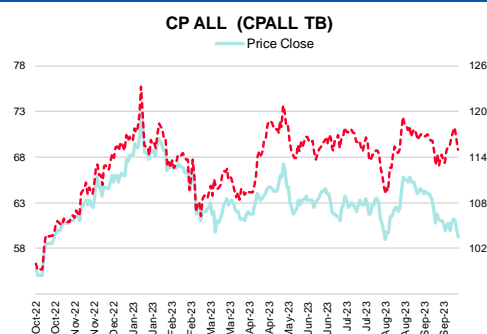

Recommendation Chart

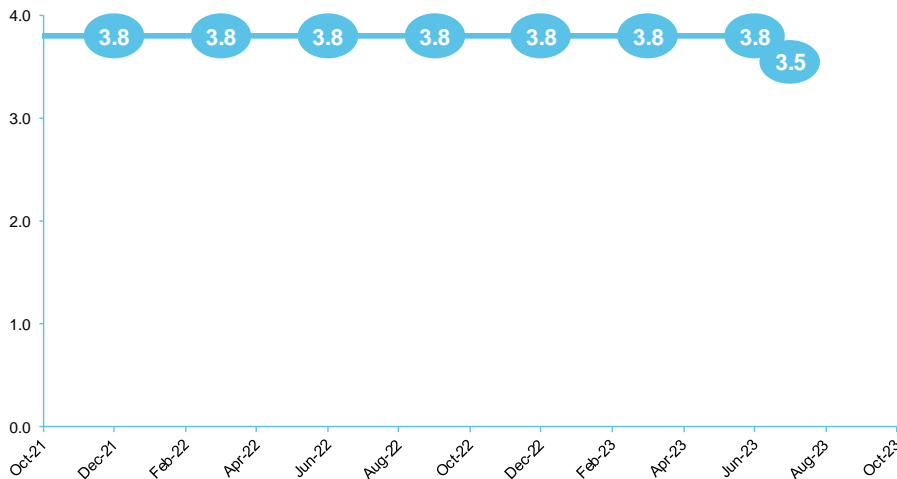
