# Land and Houses (LH TB)

# More Engines To Drive FY23 Growth; Keep BUY

- Keep BUY, higher THB10.85 TP (SOP) from THB9.50, 11% upside and >5% yield. Based on its FY23 business plan, Land and Houses is focusing on its key strength in the mid- to high-end single-detached house (SDH) segment to drive core revenue growth. We also think Thailand's full re-opening on a full-year basis will help amplify LH's growth prospects.
- Achievable FY22 presales highlighted by SDH. LH's major FY22 achievement should be the full-year presales of THB30.2bn, which grew a consistent 6% YoY and neared its THB31bn FY22 target. This success was attributed to the consistent 7% YoY growth in the SDH segment and strong 171% YoY growth from FY21's low base within the condominium wing. Only the townhouse segment commanded deteriorating presales (-37% YoY) of THB2.49bn, as LH did not focus on this medium-end segment due to limited affordability. Within FY22, 97% of new project values launched comprised SDH projects. The remaining 3% was from townhouses. No condominiums were launched. Note: LH met its FY22 target of launching new projects worth THB32.5bn in total.
- Higher FY23 targets with static focus. Based on management's FY23 business plan, the SDH segment will retain its important role in driving LH's growth performance. FY23 presales has been set to grow 16% YoY to THB35bn while presales from SDH projects will maintain its largest proportion of this (83%; similar to FY21 and FY22 numbers). Townhouses will remain out of sight, in our view, in anticipation of a further 28% drop in presales. Condominium presales are set to grow at a strong 94% YoY based on the resumption of one large-sized condominium to be launched in FY23. Note: LH is planning to launch only one condominium project the THB6.5bn The Key Srinakarin - in 3Q23 to tap into the extended family with limited budget market within its best-selling location for SDHs.
- Asset monetisation resumption. After the absence of US asset sales during FY22 - due to bond yield spikes pressuring asset prices - LH is planning to sell off at least one of its Grand Centre Point hotels in Pattaya within 4Q23. In case of these two projects are simultaneously sold off to a REIT, we expect a 15% upside on top of our FY23F earnings.
- Slightly weaker performance expected in 4Q22. Although 4Q should be another quarter for strong earnings performance, especially from LH's SDH projects, we expect a 5% YoY net profit drop to THB1.9bn - under pressure from FX losses. However, FY22 earnings should grow a strong 19% YoY on higher revenue from project sales and stronger profit-sharing from associated firms. Based on our in-house proprietary methodology, we derive an ESG score of 3.4. Accordingly, we apply a 2% premium to our higher SOP-derived intrinsic value to arrive at a THB10.85 TP - up 14.8% - as we roll over the base year for its core business and adjust the fair values of the company's SET-listed investments.

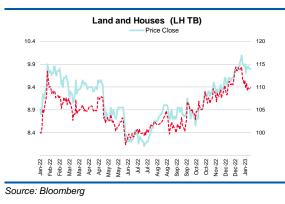
