TMBThanachart Bank (TTB TB)

Buy (Maintained)

2Q24F Earnings, 1H24F Yield To Outpace Peers; BUY

Target Price (Return): THB2.10 (+21%)
 Price (Market Cap): THB1.74 (USD4,597m)
 ESG score: 3.1 (out of 4)
 Avg Daily Turnover (THB/USD) 373m/9.94m

- **Keep BUY and THB2.10 TP, 21% upside and c.7% yield.** TMBThanachart Bank remains our preferred sector pick from its: i) Its outstanding dividend yield (7-8% vs c.5% for the sector) and earnings growth (12% in FY24F vs peers: c.3-5%); ii) stronger risk absorption capabilities and reserve cushion, and iii) earnings cushion – thanks to a huge tax benefit to be recognised as a tax reversal by 2028. This advantage will enable the bank to be in a better position to manage asset quality risk and any impending challenges vs peers.
- **Expect 2Q24F net profit at THB5.3bn (+17%YoY, flat QoQ) – top performer YoY vs the sector** (estimated at c.+2% YoY, -3% QoQ). The outstanding growth, especially YoY, should be mainly due to the continuous utilisation of the tax benefits (remaining amount as of 1Q24: THB14.1bn). The likely flat earnings QoQ should be dragged by lower non-NII mainly from the dull capital market (SET Index: -4% QTD, -7% YTD and -18% YoY) and NIM contraction (c.-9bps QoQ; 1Q24: -16bps QoQ) from the ongoing impact of deposit repricing. We expect the bank to lower its credit cost to c.135bps in 2Q24 (vs 153bps in 1Q24 and its normalised guidance of 125-135bps for 2024) to help smooth its earnings. Loans are expected to weaken (c.-4% YoY, -1% QoQ vs its flat guidance for 2024) as the bank still prioritises quality over growth.
- **Asset quality to be manageable.** NPL ratio in 2Q24 is likely to increase slightly QoQ due to the QoQ loan drop and pressure from high household debt and uneven economic growth – this should impact the vulnerable small SME and lower income retail segments. However, we expect TTB to be able to manage this asset quality challenge well and see a lower impact vs peers – thanks to the tax benefit cushion and its lower risk loan structure (lower exposure in the small SME, used car auto hire purchase loan, and lower-end retail segments. However, the speeding up of the budget disbursement in 2H24 should help ease asset quality pressure, especially from 2H24.
- **1H24F and FY24 dividend yield to outpace peers.** TTB's key appeal remains its being among the top three dividend play stocks in the sector, only behind SCBX (SCB TB, BUY, TP: THB124; FY24F dividend yield: c.10%). We expect TTB to pay dividend for 1H24F (at c.TH0.05-0.06) and FY24F (TH0.13), representing an outstanding dividend yield of 3-3.5% and 7-8% (peers: at c.1-2% and 5-6%).
- **Inexpensive valuation.** Its P/BV remains below -0.5SD from the historical mean. Our TP includes a 2% ESG discount based on TTB's ESG score of 3.1.

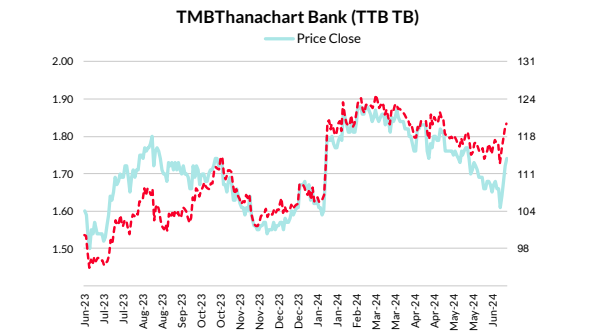

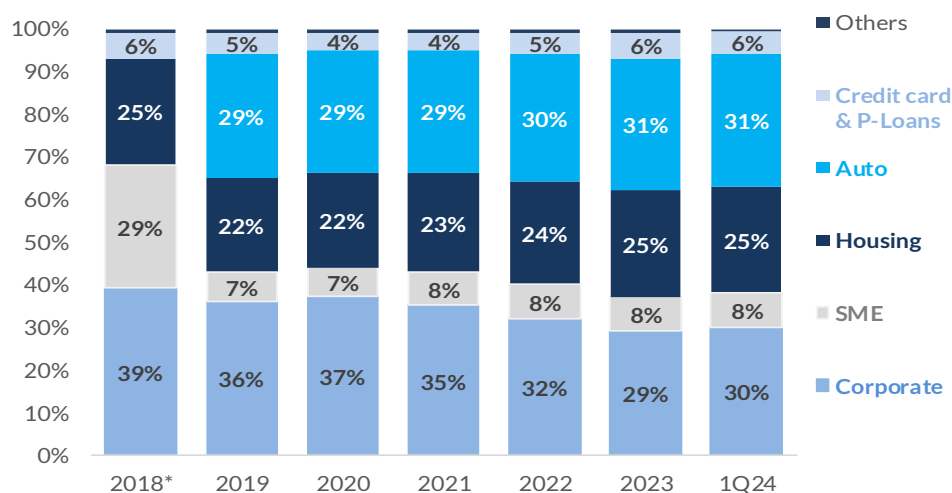

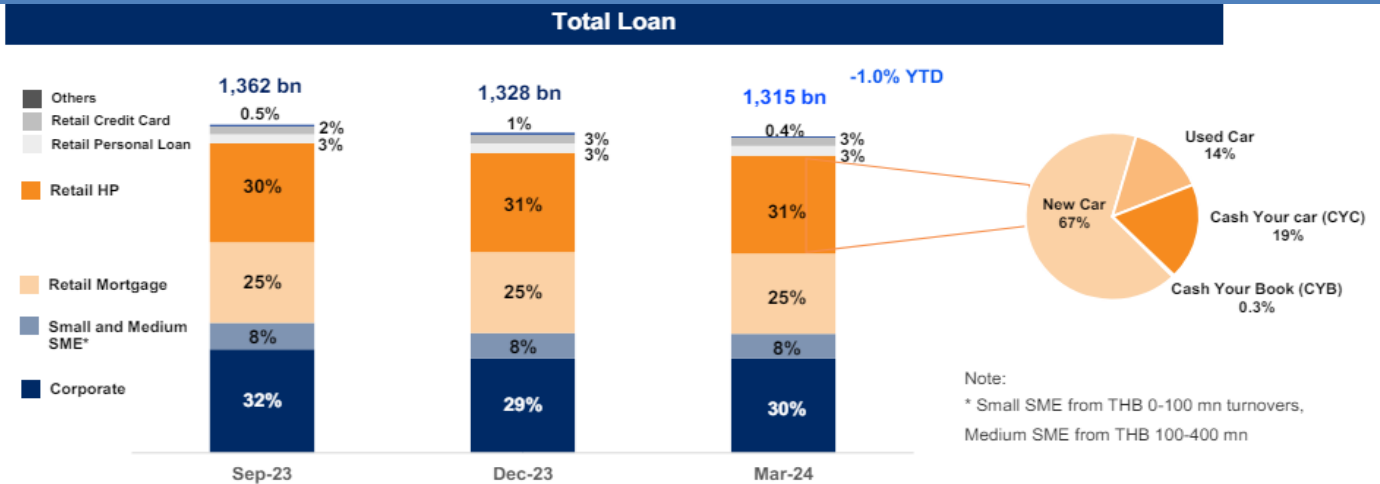
Figure 2: TTB's loan structure

Figure 3: TTB's loan structure



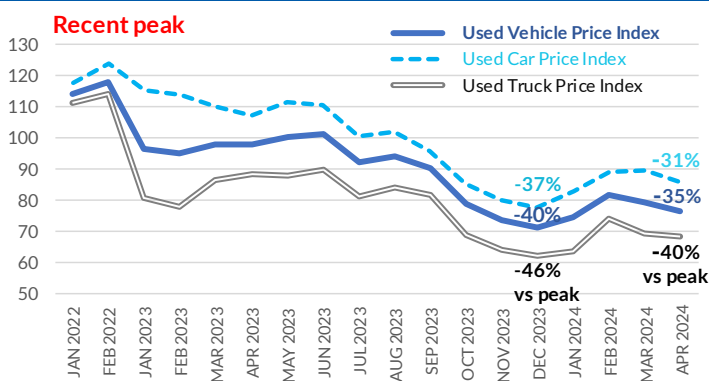

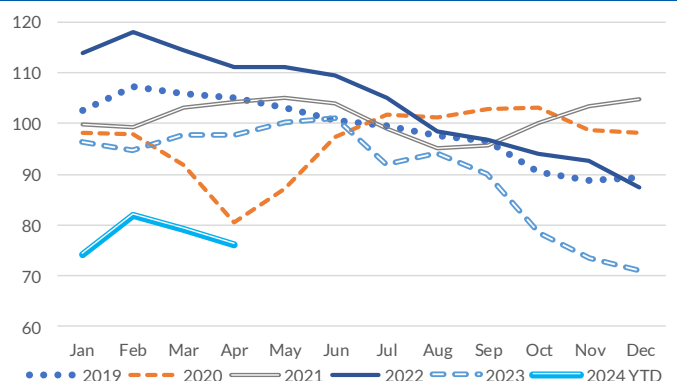

Figure 6: Used Vehicle Price Index 2019-YTD 2024



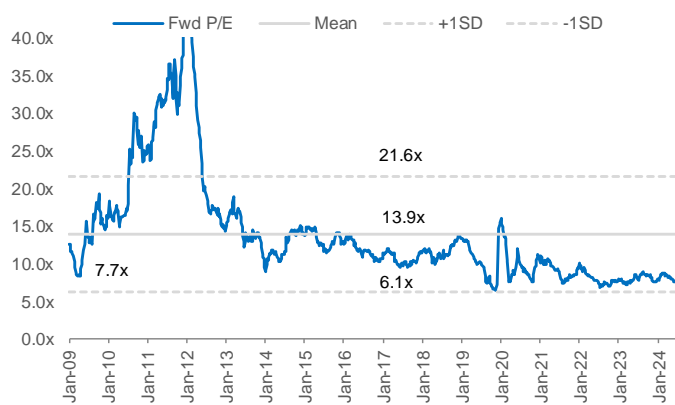

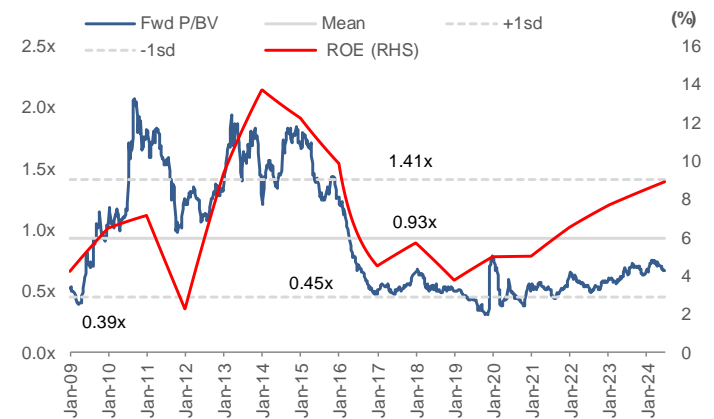

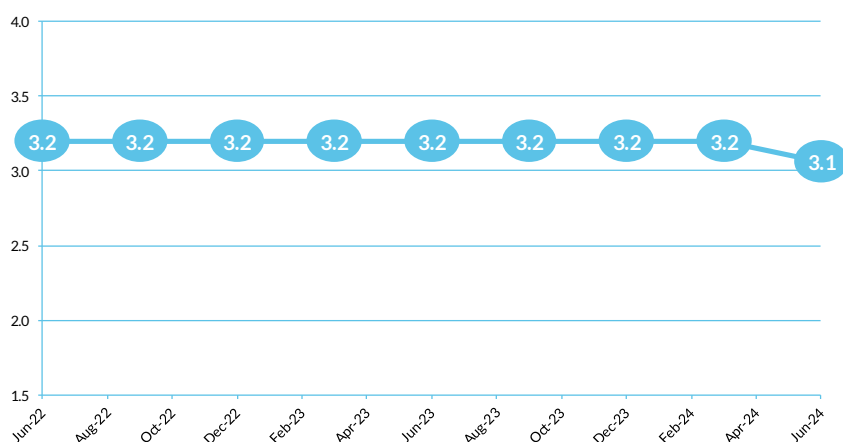
