- **Keep BUY and THB51 TP, 50% upside and c.5% yield.** We have a positive view on PTT Group's Rayong battery plant, LNG terminal, and its innovative projects, following a recent site visit. While PTT's performance may be slightly weaker in 3Q22 – due to energy prices being lower than its peak in 2Q22 – it should remain at high levels. In the long term, PTT is working to capitalise on future business trends, such as in the EV-related space, and innovations in health and environmental products.

- **Positive view on battery plant.** PTT arranged a site visit to its plant in the Rayong province last week (29-30 Sep) in the Eastern Economic Corridor area. We visited the battery plant, which focuses on semi-solid batteries. A solid-state battery is a rechargeable energy storage system, similar in overall structure and operation to the more familiar lithium-ion battery. The difference is that lithium-ion batteries contain a liquid electrolyte, while solid-state batteries (as its name suggests) feature a solid one. This allows solid-state batteries to be lighter, have more energy density, provide more range, and recharge faster. Thailand's EV market remains untapped, presenting a huge long-term opportunity, in line with the Government's target to increase EVs to 50% of total vehicle production by 2030, and 100% by 2035.

- **Integrated LNG terminal.** PTT plans to commence commercial operations of its LNG Terminal 2 in December. The project will enhance the competitiveness of the country's natural gas business, support LNG imports to meet demand, build long-term power security for Thailand, and drive the country towards becoming ASEAN's Regional LNG Hub. As Terminals 1 and 2 have some distance between them, PTT will construct an interconnection pipeline between the terminals to provide more convenience. Customers will be able to load at any of the two terminals, and the pipeline can support and manage LNG between the terminals. Customers will also be able to send LNG via the pipeline to their onshore buyers. The LNG facilities will improve the country's energy logistics and security. We also visited several environmentally friendly facilities such as the Envicco project, which produces plastic resin via recycling items from households throughout Thailand, as well as the Viriyasirimethi Institute of Science and Technology and the PTIC Technology and Innovation Center, which aim to increase innovation for PTT.

- **3Q22 to fall from peak but remain at high levels.** 3Q22 results will likely be slightly lower QoQ, due to lower energy prices, but remain in the high range and up YoY on the back of increased volumes from its gas business.

- **ESG overlay.** PTT has successfully applied ESG principles into its operations. We derived an ESG score of 3.7, and applied an 8% premium to our valuation to arrive at our TP. Keep BUY for to its attractive 5% yield.

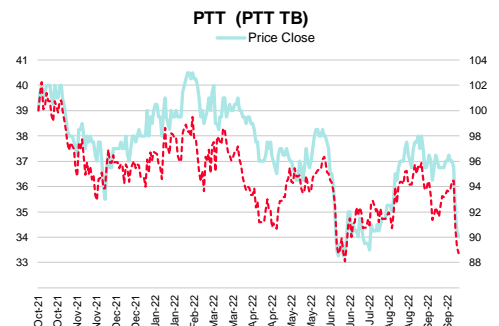

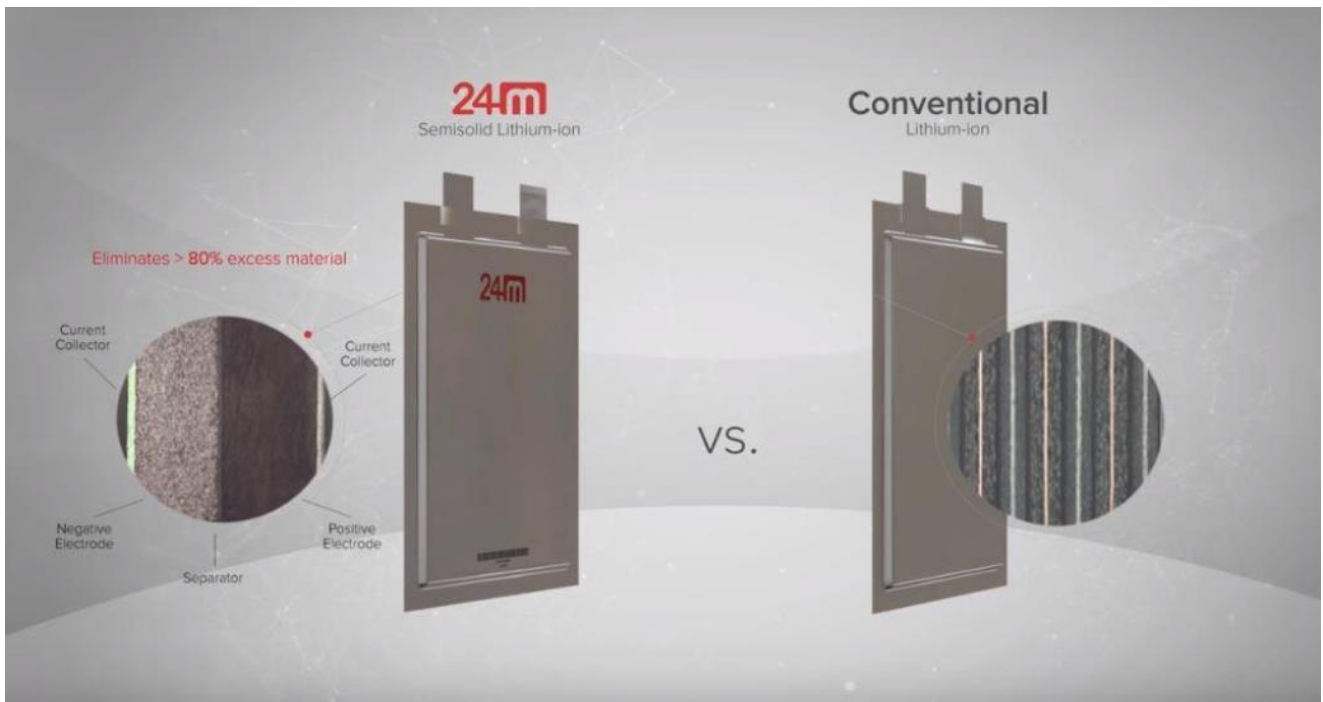

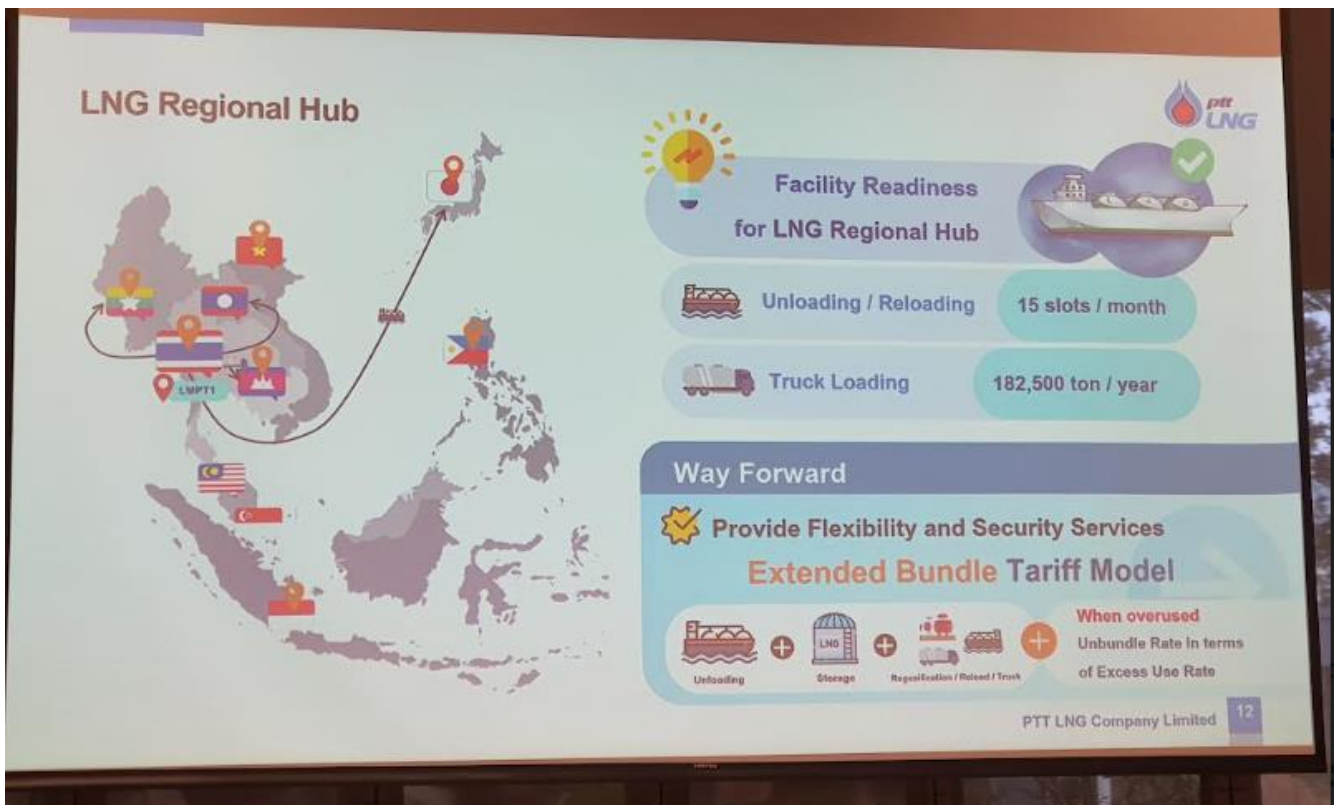

Figure 1: Semi-solid battery eliminates excess material with lower weight, more electrical storage than the conventional type



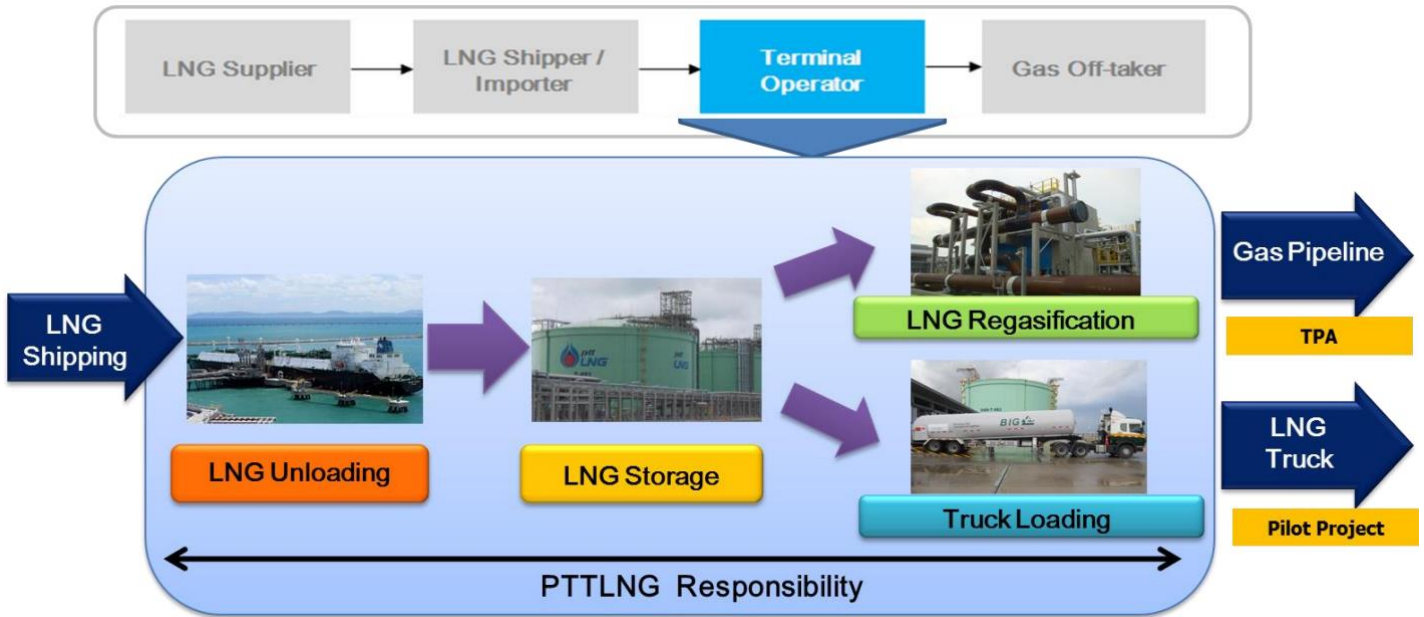

Figure 2: PTT aims to create an LNG regional hub with its interconnection of both offshore and inland regional logistics



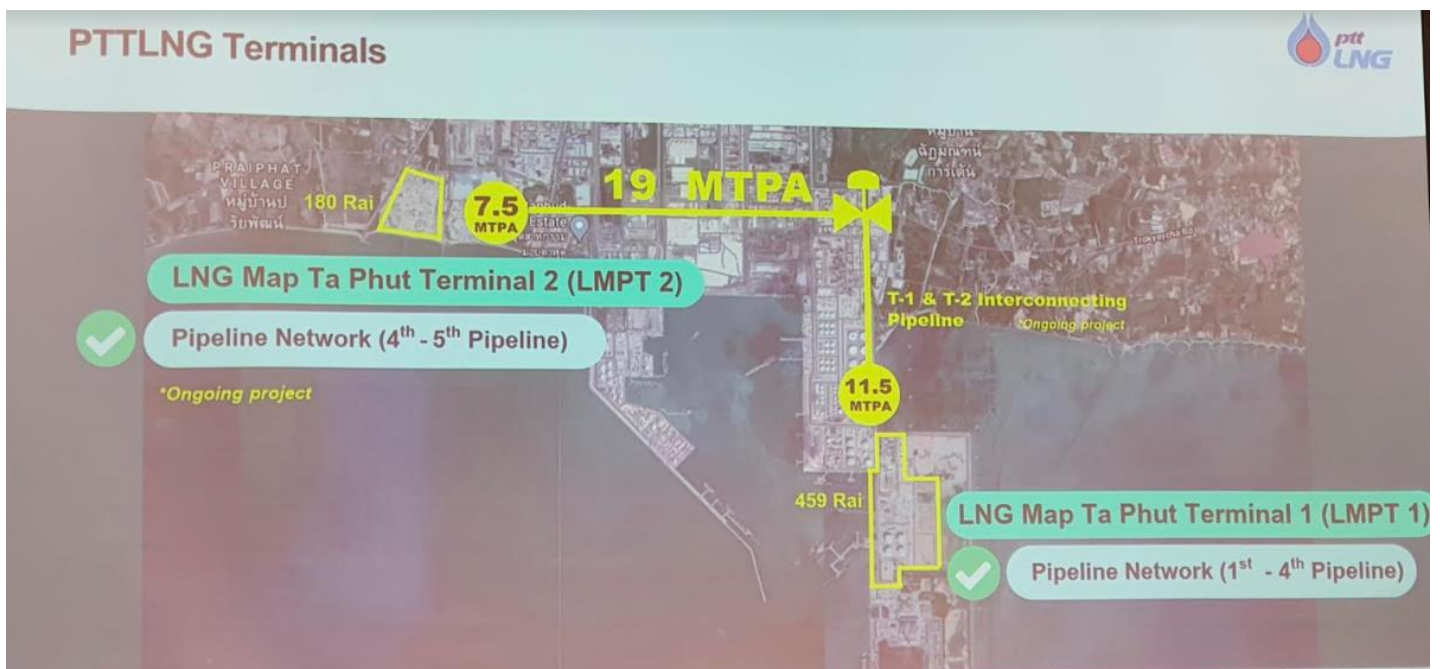

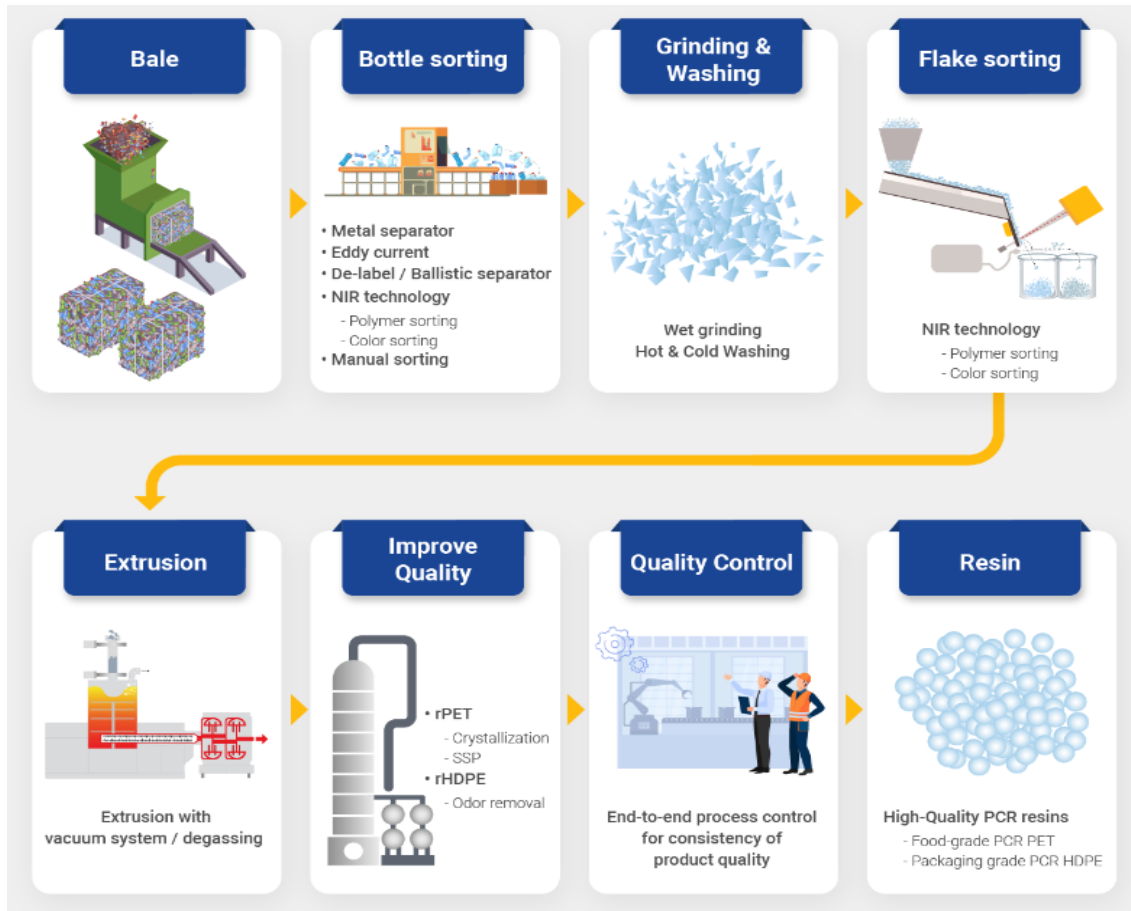

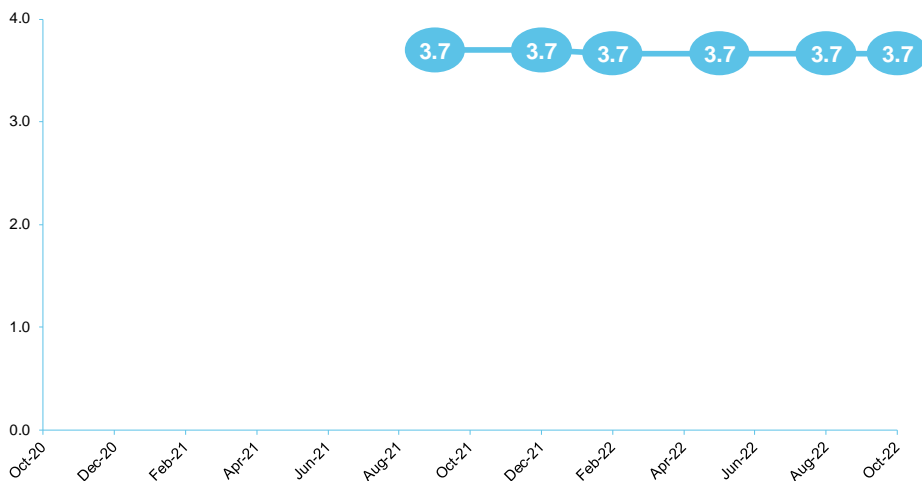
