Performance Set To Peak In 2Q-3Q24; Still BUY

Target Price (Return): THB42.50 (31.8%)
 Price (Market Cap): THB32.25 (USD5,061m)

- **Keep BUY and THB42.50 TP (32% upside), c.2% yield.** 1Q24 may be Minor International's weakest quarter of the year. A high season for hotels in Europe could make the company's 2Q-3Q24F earnings stronger than its local peers. Its efficient strategies should also widen its topline and profit margins. MINT is our Top Pick in the Thailand hotel sector.
- **1Q24 results recap.** 1Q24 net profit of THB1.15bn represented a turnaround from 1Q23's net loss of THB976m, and was up 16% QoQ. Without non-recurring items, it booked a 1Q24 core loss of THB352m, narrower than the THB647m core loss of 1Q23 (4Q23: THB2.50bn core profit). The key reason was the low season for its hotels in Europe. Still, the smaller losses were supported by an improved flow-through from revenue, enhanced efficiency, and effective cost management. Its owned and leased hotels' revenue per available rooms (RevPar) grew 35% above 1Q19's levels.
- **Stronger hotel outlook.** We anticipate solid 2Q-3Q24F earnings, driven by the peak period for hotels in Europe (56% of MINT's 2023 topline), as leisure demand has remained strong and corporate customers are improving. World sports events (Summer Olympics in Paris, UEFA Euro 2024 in Germany) and scheduled high-profile concerts should benefit its hotels there. Its Thailand properties (9% revenue mix) could be supported by the ongoing surge in foreign tourist arrivals with higher spending. MINT's strategy to maximise its average daily rate (ADR) via hotel brand upgrades of existing properties, asset enhancements, and room upselling may also drive topline and profit margins, as well as cover higher staff costs (minimum wage hikes).
- **Food wing recovery.** MINT's food business should be driven by its Thailand hub (12% revenue mix), given its strategies to enhance brand value (ie offering premium products), increase profitable dine-in and takeaway contribution, and open new outlets. While its China operations (3% revenue mix) may still see sluggish SSSG in 2Q24 (1Q24: -27% YoY) from last year's high base before improving in 2H24, the hub's profitability should still be favourable on efficient cost controls.
- **2Q24 QTD data.** April RevPar rose 9% and 7% YoY for its hotels in Europe and Thailand, driven by occupancy and room rates. Its Europe operations should see better momentum in May and June. The Thai food business may continue seeing +2% YoY SSSG in April (1Q24: +1.8%) driven by key brands.
- **Maintain forecasts.** We expect 16% core profit growth in FY24 to another record level of THB8.29bn, driven by: i) 7% total sales growth based on a conservative 8% hotel RevPar growth and +1% food SSSG, and ii) higher GPM by 1.9ppts on continued improvements in operating leverage. 2Q24F earnings should expand strongly YoY and see a turnaround QoQ.
- **Valuation.** Our TP includes a 6% ESG premium. MINT's 23x FY24F P/E remains attractive, as its core profit has exceeded pre-pandemic levels.

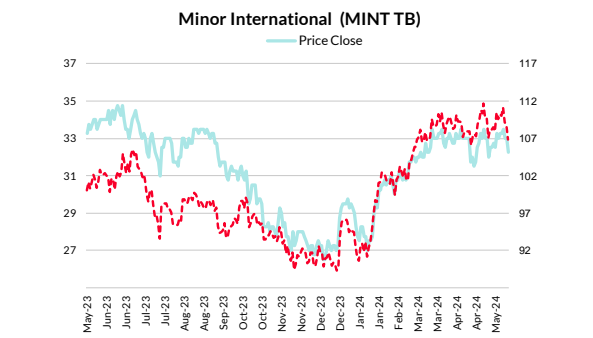

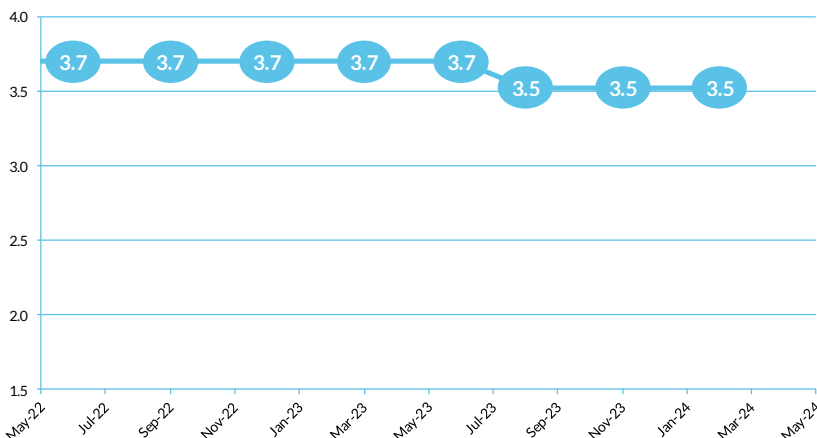

Latest ESG-Related Developments

- MINT was included in Dow Jones Sustainability Emerging Markets Index (DJSI) 2022 for hotels, resorts and cruise line industry for the ninth consecutive year. It was included in S&P Global's Sustainability Yearbook Member 2022, and received an MSCI ESG rating of AA as of 2022.
- The company has set new goals to achieve by 2025, including a 15% reduction in energy intensity for Minor Hotels (baseline 2019), 15% reduction in CO₂ emission intensity for Minor Hotels (baseline 2019), and 10% reduction in water intensity for Minor Hotels (baseline 2022).
