Rising health awareness during the pandemic has led branded health products demand to remain intact – hence, earnings growth should mostly remain resilient against softened margin prospects.

Economic Research

Core Inflation Growth Falls To Zero In May

- Thailand's Consumer Price Index (CPI) fell 3.4% YoY in May, its sharpest decline since Jul 2009. The decline was a further deterioration from April's 3%.
- Core inflation, which strips off raw food and fuel prices, was flattish during this period, its slowest growth since Oct 2009 – this was as domestic demand was hurt by COVID-19.
- We maintain our view that Thailand will fall into a deflation of 0.8% for this year, given the negative impact of the pandemic on local demand.

OPEC+ To Either Comply Or Compensate

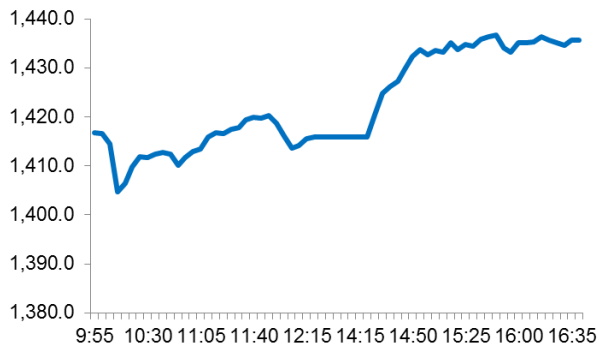
Sector Update

Top Picks: PTT Exploration & Production (PTTEP), MISC and Keppel (KEP). OPEC+ has agreed to extend its 9.7mbpd production cut until July, while stipulating that participating countries that have not complied during May-Jun will have to compensate for this, in Jul-Sep. We note that Libya is now poised to restart production in June/July, making the production cut compliance all the more crucial in this fragile market. Our 2020F crude oil price is now at USD43.00/bbl (from USD40.00/bbl), due to the deeper supply cut from OPEC+.
