## **Bangkok Expressway and Metro** (BEM TB)

## **Resumption Of Growth Ahead; BUY**

- Keep BUY and SOP-based THB9.90 TP, 22% upside, with c.2% yield. Although Bangkok Expressway and Metro's 1Q22 earnings came in below our estimates, we expect the company's growth to resume from 2Q22, with FY22 performance likely to improve significantly. The bid for the Orange-Line MRT project should be a major catalyst for BEM this year.
- 1Q22 earnings result below our estimates. BEM announced 1Q22 net profit of THB336m (+10% YoY, -15% QoQ), albeit with relatively flat 1Q22 core revenue of THB3.1bn (-0.5% YoY, +1% QoQ). Revenue of THB1.9bn (+1.8% YoY, +0.6% QoQ) from the expressway business rose YoY mainly from the hike in toll fees, as stated in the concession agreement of the Si Rat-Outer Ring Road Expressway project on 15 Dec 2021 - despite traffic volumes on all expressway sections dipping slightly by 1%YoY to 961.8k trips/day. Revenue from the MRT business, however, declined YoY to THB991m (-3% YoY, +6.5% QoQ) as farebox revenue from the Blue-Line MRT project was pressured by the pandemic's impact, resulting in 1Q22 average ridership declining moderately by 12% YoY to 187.8k trips/day. Commercial development revenue declined to THB196m (-8.7% YoY, -15.7% QoQ) mainly due to shrinking advertising revenue, in line with the private sector's stringent controls over advertising during the pandemic. GPM was a major factor for the disappointing 1Q22 earnings, as it fell to 38.4% vs our estimate of 41.1%.
- Sideways pattern in 4M22. Key indicators for expressways and the Blue-Line MRT have been similar, showing a flat pattern from Jan-Apr 2022. Average expressway traffic in 4M22 stayed within the range of 900k and 1m/day, while average Blue-Line MRT ridership remained between 170k and 200k. For 4M22, average expressway traffic rose slightly by 2.6% YoY. However, average ridership for the Blue-Line MRT fell 5.7% YoY. This implies that the impact of the pandemic on MRT ridership remains high, with ridership negatively impacted since early this year.
- FY22 earnings to jump YoY. Based on the actual 4M22 numbers, we expect expressway traffic and MRT ridership to increase gradually from May to Dec 2022, while management foresees FY22 numbers (1-1.1m expressway traffic/day, and 250k ridership/day) to reach FY20 levels. Based on lower amortisation costs in the expressway business, we expect FY22F net profit to possibly jump almost 200% YoY.
- Maintain TP. Based on our in-house proprietary methodology, we assign an ESG score of 3.3 for BEM. As the ESG score is on par with the country median, we assign a 0% premium/discount to arrive at our DCF-based THB9.90 TP.



### Figure 2: Expressway traffic numbers were almost flat from Jan-Apr 2022; its 4-month average rose slightly by 2.6% YoY





Figure 3: Blue-Line MRT ridership was also flat from Jan-Apr 2022; 4-month average declined 5.7%YoY


