Recovery Ahead With Tight Supply And High GRM

Target Price (Return): THB4.50 (+31%)

- Maintain BUY and a THB4.50 TP, 31% upside with c.6% FY22F yield. IRPC's refinery business is set to perform well, supported by higher GRM and better utilisation rates. The EU has set an embargo for Russian imports – which should increase supply tensions and keep oil prices high. As such, IRPC should record a strong GRM in 2Q22.
- EU to set embargo on Russian oil. The EU-wide ban will affect oil that arrives by sea equivalent to around two-thirds of its oil imports but not pipeline oil, following opposition on this ban from Hungary. Other landlocked countries like Slovakia and the Czech Republic also requested for more time, due to their dependence on Russian oil. The landlocked importers also have more logistic costs than those that import oil transported via sea, since they will need to increase imports from alternative sources. In the meantime, Poland and Germany have also pledged to end pipeline imports, which implies that a total of 90% of Russian oil imports will be blocked. These developments also intensify tensions between Russia and Ukraine and should keep oil prices elevated.
- Recovery trend ahead. The Singapore benchmark GRM in 2Q22F should average USD21.00/bbl (+169% QoQ). Meanwhile, the diesel spread is estimated to hover at around USD30.00/bbl, vs USD19.00/bbl in 1Q22 mainly due to the Russia-Ukraine conflict. As such, we expect IRPC's market GRM to improve to approximately USD6.00-7.00/bbl this quarter, compared with USD4.19/bbl in 1Q22. IRPC's utilisation rate should also rise to 94%, from 90% in 1Q22 and boost its earnings. This could alleviate the company's high crude oil premiums and loss from oil hedging.
- Some maintenance exercises possible in 4Q22, but this is all within its plan. IRPC will engage in maintenance works at some facilities in 4Q22. However, this is a part of its long-term operational plan, and should have a limited effect on its numbers.
- Assigning ESG to valuations. IRPC has become a successful player in applying ESG principles in developing sustainable operations. Based on our proprietary methodology, we derive a 3.3 ESG score, which is on par with the country median. Accordingly, we apply a 0% premium to our intrinsic value of THB4.50, which in turn is based on 1.1x P/BV in line with its 5-year mean. This counter has a cheap valuation (at -1SD from the P/BV mean), and offers a handsome c.6% dividend yield. As such, we make no change to our BUY recommendation.
- Downside risks to our recommendation include a weaker-than-expected global economic recovery, and adverse changes in new supply entering the market.

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

Valuation basis

For Thai refineries/petrochemical counters, we use P/BV as a valuation basis. This is due to the high volatility in earnings as a result of stock gains/losses. We believe that the DCF valuation is not appropriate, as share prices and earnings are highly subject to seasonal factors.

Key drivers

- i. Crude oil prices, as it is the main feedstock;
- GRM, as it is seasonally dependent on the demand and supply of the refined product;
 Stock gains/losses as a result of crude oil price
- volatility;
- Positive effect of a change in the THB/USD rate, where product and feedstock costs are priced in USD.

Key risks

- Volatility of crude oil prices;
- ii. Fluctuating THB/USD rate;
- iii. Product supply and demand.


