• Maintain NEUTRAL with a revised THB4.20 TP from THB4.00, 1% upside. IRPC posted a core net profit of THB223m in 1Q21 vs 4Q20's THB364m core loss, underpinned by stronger refinery and petrochemical spreads. However, the results were softer than expected, as utilisation rates dipped amid planned maintenance shutdowns. Looking ahead, we expect its refinery's performance to hold up on progressive demand recovery, although the group's petrochemical margins could be reined in by incremental supply pressures.




• Slightly below expectations. Headline net profit surged 247% QoQ to THB5.6bn, largely attributable to hefty net stock gains of THB5bn or USD9.80/bbl — in tandem with the rebound in crude oil prices. After adjusting for non-recurring items, however, core net profit came up to THB223m, which was slightly below our expectations. The negative variance arose mainly from lower-than-expected refinery utilisation rates (86% vs 4Q20's 92%), as the group brought forward its plant maintenance schedule. That said, market GIM rose above the operating breakeven level of USD11.40/bbl to USD13.70/bbl (4Q20: USD11.00/bbl) thanks to stronger product spreads across its refinery and petrochemical segments. This was partly aided by temporary supply outages in regional markets.

• Additional plant downtime scheduled in subsequent quarters. Relative to IRPC's earlier guidance, we gather that management has planned for additional maintenance works over the rest of the year – especially between April and July – for both its refinery and petrochemical plants. However, the reduced run rates should be partly mitigated by healthy GIM levels, whereby we expect a continued improvement in refinery spreads to make up for a normalisation in petrochemical margins once the present market imbalances are corrected.



• Earnings estimates. We trim FY21F-23F earnings by 5-13% after incorporating higher crude cost assumptions in addition to lower refinery run rates for 2021. We flag the quantum of demand recovery as a key risk, as supply is also expected to recover progressively over 2021.

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•	Stay NEUTRAL with higher TP of THB4.20. This comes after rolling
	forward our valuation base to 2022F, based on an unchanged P/BV target
	multiple of 1.1x, in line with the 5-year mean. Our call is maintained, as we
	believe the stock is fairly valued at current levels. Upside/downside risks
	include stronger-/weaker-than-expected economic recovery driving
	demand and quicker-/slower-than-expected supply additions to the market.

Valuation basis

For Thai refineries/petrochemical counters, we use P/BV as a valuation basis. This is due to the high volatility in earnings as a result of stock gains/losses. We believe DCF valuation is not appropriate, as share prices and earnings are highly seasonal

Key drivers

- i. Crude oil prices, as it is the main feedstock;
- ii. GRM, seasonally dependent on the demand and supply of the refined product;
- Stock gains/losses as a result of crude oil price volatility;
- iv. THB/USD rate, where product and feedstock costs are priced in USD.

Key risks

- i. Volatility of crude oil price;
- ii. Fluctuating THB/USD rate;
- iii. Product supply and demand
