# Kiatnakin Phatra Financial Group (KKP TB)

# **Operations To Moderate In 2H21**

- Keep NEUTRAL and THB56.00 TP, 4% upside. Kaitnakin Phatra Financial Group's 2Q21 performance was lower with a higher expected credit loss (ECL) and negative JAWS. Although we expect 2H21F earnings to be modest in line with the evolving COVID-19 outbreak, we retain our forecasts for now pending for the meeting on 23 Jul. Our preferred stock remains TISCO Financial (TISCO, BUY, TP: THB111.00) for its superior asset quality, conservative management strategies, and compelling dividend yield.
- 2Q21 missed expectations. 2Q21 net profit was THB1,354m (-7% QoQ; +14% YoY) at 17% and 7% below our and Street forecasts. 1H21 earnings of THB2,817m (+6% YoY) accounted for 50% of our FY21F. Annualised ROE slipped to 11.3% (1Q21: 12.4%), while CET-1 rose to 17%.
- Stable PIOP, but higher ECL. Operating income grew 4% QoQ mainly on a 16% QoQ surge in non-II, following stronger capital market fees compensating for lower gains from investments. NII dipped 1% QoQ as a 2% rise in loans was offset by lower NIM of 4.43% (1Q21: 4.5%). Given a rise in employee expenses and losses from the sale of foreclosed assets, overheads rose 7% QoQ, pushing CIR up to 43% from 41% in 1Q21. A 12% QoQ increase in ECL also exacerbated the decline in bottomline.
- Asset quality stress rising, but manageable. Gross NPLs continued its uptrend with a 10% QoQ rise. NPL ratio was up to 3.6% (1Q21: 3.4%) vs <4.5% FY21F target. Reported LLR was lower to 160.1% from 163.3%, despite including another THB824m management overlay in 2Q21.
- Moderated loan growth. Gross loans grew a stronger 4% QoQ, from a 2% QoQ increase in 1Q21. Growth was driven by retail (+6% QoQ), and corporate (+15% QoQ) loans. Lending to commercial segment contracted 5% QoQ. Customer deposits were flattish YTD, resulting in higher LDR 110% (1Q21: 107%).
- Earnings forecasts. We make no changes to our FY21F-22F earnings pending an analysts briefing scheduled for 23 Jul. We see downside risk to our earnings with the evolving pandemic impacting KKP's operating environment. Upside risk: Higher-than-expected loan growth. Downside risk: Higher-than-expected ECL. Our TP of THB56.00 is based on GGM-derived P/BV of 0.94x.




