Ratch Group (RATCH TB)

Too Attractive To Ignore; Keep BUY

- Keep BUY and THB68.00 TP, 30% upside, c.5% yield. FY20 results were
 in line with our expectation, but beat Street's. We believe earnings will
 gradually hit a record high in FY21-22, with strong upsides from potential
 projects. Opportunities to acquire new capacities following US President
 Joe Biden's green plans should be another catalyst to drive share price
 momentum. At current P/E, valuations are undemanding with compelling
 risk/reward. Yields are higher too vis-à-vis peers' c.2.5% average.
- Going more green. We think Ratch Group is comfortable in acquiring new infrastructure projects in 2021 (at least 2-3 projects), given its solid D/E (0.61x below the 1.3x covenant level), extensive experience, and many opportunities in the power market. Management plans to grow Ratch in 2021 by c.700MW, especially in Asia's renewable energy markets, eg Vietnam, South Korea, and Japan, among others.
- FY20 results beat Street's estimates. Ratch posted a net profit of THB6.3bn (+5% YoY). Excluding FX gains from AUD/USD appreciation, core profit stood at THB5.8bn (-2% YoY). The key drag: Core revenue decreases. This was attributed to lower available payment (AP) from Ratchaburi Electricity Generating (its main facility) in line with power purchase agreements as well as decreased electricity production from Mount Emerald Wind Farm. Still, a 16% rebound in share of profits helped to mitigate the topline weakness, thanks mainly to a better performance from the Hongsa power plant in accordance with a higher AP and insurance claims, as well as lower finance costs.
- A rebound in 4Q20 results. Ratch's net and core profits were booked at THB2.1bn (+24% QoQ, +135% YoY) and THB1.9bn (+19% QoQ, +173% YoY). A stronger share of profits played a key role in both a QoQ and YoY basis, mainly on Hongsa's impressive performance, new recognition of Nava Nakorn Electricity Generating's expansion, and Berkprai Cogeneration. Moreover, impressive earnings were aided by a higher GPM of 13% vs 3Q20 and 4Q19's 11% and 10%.
- Expecting slight increases in 1Q21 earnings. A summer season which leads to higher APs and electricity demand and improving economic activities should help boost 1Q21 core revenue. Still, these factors will be mitigated by lower share of profits, in our view. Note: Hongsa plans to do maintenance at Unit2 for c.28 days during 1Q21. It has three units
- Earnings revision. We slightly revise up our FY21F-22F earnings by 3-4% to take into account: i) Dividend income from Bangkok Aviation Fuel Service (c.THB120m pa Ratch has invested 15.53% of its total shares since 19 Jan), ii) higher profit contributions from Hongsa, and iii) lower finance costs in line with its refinancing initiatives. Maintain BUY and THB68.00 TP.




Figure 3: Ratch's implied P/BV at different SD levels
