Lower Tuna Costs To Improve Cost Management

• Keep BUY and THB24.00 TP, 38% upside with c.4% FY22F yield. Lower tuna prices have watered down raw material costs earlier than expected – and Thai Union can now accumulate cheaper raw materials for future production. As such, revenue should improve in the long term, underpinned by the recovery of consumption. TU may feel some near-term pressure from its energy and raw material costs, but should do better in 2H when demand rises again. Its diversified businesses, innovative products, and the hidden value of its petcare unit should allow for a robust long-term outlook.

• Lower tuna prices due to more fishing and improved stock management. The price of skipjack tuna fell to USD1,600 per tonne in May (+25% YoY, -11% MoM) – marking a huge drop from the peak of USD1,900 per tonne in March. This is a positive for TU, as tuna costs have decreased for two consecutive months (ie USD1,800 per tonne in April and 1,600 per

tonne in May). The price in May was even lower than the manageable price threshold of USD1,900 per tonne, as well as TU's own earlier projection of USD1,800 per tonne – which is a big positive factor. As such, TU should be able to stockpile more fish at this time, which would enable it to run while

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

Demand should recover in tandem with the economic reopening. TU
should book stronger QoQ numbers in 2Q22, while the global economic
recovery is expected to improve further in 2H22. As such, we expect 2Q22
earnings to grow QoQ, due to: i) TU adjusting its selling prices by c.6-8%,
which may partly reduce the impact of raw material costs; as well as ii)
better demand from the hotel, restaurant and café segment, underpinned
by the further reopening and recovery of more economies around the world.



• Opportunities in the long run. The group plans to list its petcare business i-Tail (ITC) in 2H22. TU plans to sell not more than 660m ITC shares, which should be allocated as: i) New 600m shares issued; and ii) the sale of 60m shares of its original stake in the firm. Post-IPO, TU's holdings in ITC will represent 77.64% of the latter's paid-up capital. The group's shareholders will also have pre-emptive rights to buy ITC shares relative to their stakes in TU. The group's stake will, therefore, consist of the hidden value of its premium petcare business. The petcare business fetches higher margins of c.23-27%, vs seafood's c.17-18%.

Assigning ESG to valuations. Based on our proprietary methodology, we
derive an ESG score of 3.4 out of 4 for TU. Accordingly, we apply a 2%
premium to our DCF-based intrinsic value, to derive TP of THB24.00. TU is
still able to pay attractive dividends, with a yield of about 4% for this year.

TU aims to support environmental products and has a strong policy of supporting environment-friendly suppliers. All its plants comply with environmental and waste treatment standards.

S: GOOD

Being reliant on seafood product and fishermen suppliers, TU has the highest exposure to this ESG pillar. However, it has managed its social and community relationships well. The company has a strong policy of not supporting labour malpractice suppliers. TU also applies international standards specified by Dow Jones Sustainability Indices and United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. It also conducts its social responsibility activities based on engaging in projects that are suitable for society's needs.

G: EXCELLENT

TU follows the guidance of the Thai Institute of Directors. Its disclosure policy is in compliance with regulations set by the SET. As it is a listed company, TU also discloses important information broadly and promptly to stakeholders.




