

TOA applies Greenovation and strives to offer innovations for consumer health and environmental sustainability. It does this by managing the environment and conforming to the environment management system standard of ISO 14001.

S: GOOD

The company has set its corporate social responsibility policy, under its ethics committee, to ensure fairness towards all stakeholders. TOA also complies with the policy to care for and build relationships with nearby communities, by regularly promoting such communities activities when considering projects. G: EXCELLENT

TOA aims to operate its business with fairness, honesty, and transparency, while disclosing material information based on accountability and auditability. The company considers both the benefits and impacts that may be experienced by shareholders, customers, business partners, employees, and all stakeholders. In addition, its fair benefit-sharing is seen as appropriate.

• Maintain BUY and DCF-based THB33.70 TP, 20% upside and c.2% dividend yield. After dealing with the cost-surge situation over the past year, TOA Paint is mitigating the impact by revising up its products' selling prices. With this, we expect the company to be able to manage the situation from 3Q22 onwards, and for profitability to gradually return to normal levels.

- Full impact from cost-push factors in 1Q22. After the surge in costs especially from titanium dioxide and oil-linked substances - significantly pressured GPM to below 30%, resulting in a 27% YoY decline in 1Q22 core profit, we expect the situation to improve from 2Q22 onwards. In order to partially mitigate the cost-push effect from FY21, the company's decided to increase its products' selling prices, and this was one of the major factors that boosted 1Q22 sales revenue (+12% YoY, +6% QoQ) while sales revenue growth in Vietnam (+47% YoY) outpaced the domestic market (+9%YoY).
- GPM pressures to alleviate from 2Q22. Once again, TOA has responded to the significantly higher costs in 1Q22 with another round of upward revisions to its product selling prices, effective Mar 2022. Prices in its decorative paint segment have been revised up by 8%, while prices in the non-decorative product segment were revised 4% higher. After hitting the low-ebb level of 29.3% in 1Q22, this should bode well for 2Q22 GPM to stay above 30%, especially as major raw material costs remain at high levels, without any significant increases in the near term.
- Sales revenue growth intact. Based on the current circumstances, management is maintaining its FY22 sales revenue growth target of at least +10% YoY, supported by: i) The impact from the upward revision of its product prices and ii) stronger demand from renovation and construction after the re-opening in Jun 2022, and as developers kick off their new project launches.
- ASPs to stand firm despite cost subsides. Once energy costs come down, we expect TOA's earnings performance to rebound strongly from the full benefits of its higher ASPs. Based on the company's strategy, ASPs should stabilise from now, following the recent price revision regardless of lower raw material costs in the future. This supports our estimate that TOA's 2H22 GPM will return to pre-cost-surge levels. With its strong sales revenue growth prospects and likely GPM improvement in 2H22, core earnings should grow YoY in FY22 after declining in FY21.
- ESG overlay. Based on our proprietary methodology, we have a 2.9 ESG score for TOA. From this, we derived an initial DCF-based THB36.60 TP, and applied a 8% ESG discount to arrive at our THB33.70 TP.


