## TOA Paint (TOA TB)

**Buy** (Maintained)

### Another Quarter Of GPM Pressure; Keep BUY

Target Price (Return): THB33.70 (24.8%)  
 Price (Market Cap): THB27 (USD1,535m)  
 ESG score: 2.90 (out of 4)

- **Keep BUY and DCF-based THB33.70 TP, 25% upside and >2% yield.** Over the past year, TOA Paint has been mitigating the cost-push impact by revising up its selling prices – resulting in stronger core revenue growth. We expect its profitability to gradually normalise as soon as the cost situation reverses.
- **2Q22 core revenue likely to mark a new high.** We expect TOA to fully benefit from the impact of upward product price revisions that the company has gradually executed since FY21 – partially too from the impact of sales volume growth in some specific product segments within 2Q22. Therefore, we estimate TOA to show a new quarterly revenue record high for 2Q22 at THB5.09bn (+13% YoY, +2.5% QoQ). This is as its: i) Decorative paint segment has been serially revised up in terms of average product prices (although 2Q22 sales volumes flattened YoY and declined QoQ based on seasonality), ii) non-decorative product segment maintained its solid sales volume growth (>+10% YoY) while benefiting from the upward revision in average prices, and iii) Vietnam subsidiary's superb growth, which may command 2Q22 core revenue growth of >20% YoY. Note: This subsidiary's 2Q21 core revenue was abnormally low due to sluggish demand caused by the Vietnamese Government's strict measures to curb the pandemic situation within Vietnam.
- **2Q22 GPM to stay at bottom.** Similar to the past four quarters, 2Q22's major weakness remained profitability, given the double impacts of oil price volatility and currency depreciation. Although the majority of TOA's products portfolio has been revised up in term of average prices, this action lagged with the objective of mitigating the cost-push effects. Hence, GPMs have slid down since 2Q21. Again, 2Q22 GPM should remain in the doldrums, and we expect it to stay unchanged (from 1Q22) at 29.3%. In addition to oil prices hovering around high levels during 2Q22, the THB's depreciation against the USD throughout the quarter also hit hard on costs of imported raw materials, especially titanium dioxide.
- **Anticipating a GPM rebound.** Despite a new core revenue record high likely in 2Q22, we expect core profit to decline YoY to THB464m (-15% YoY, +4% QoQ), as low GPM should dominate the overall performance – this is despite TOA stringently controlling its advertising expenses during this period. Nevertheless, we expect its earnings performance to rebound strongly from the full benefits of the higher ASPs as soon as energy costs come down. GPMs should swing back to >30%, as the company will maintain ASPs following the recent price revisions – regardless of lower raw material costs in future.
- **Maintain TP.** Based on our proprietary methodology, we have a 2.9 ESG score for TOA. From this, we derive an initial DCF-based THB36.60 TP and applied an 8% ESG discount to arrive at our THB33.70 TP.

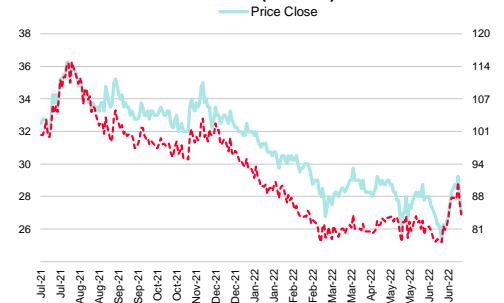

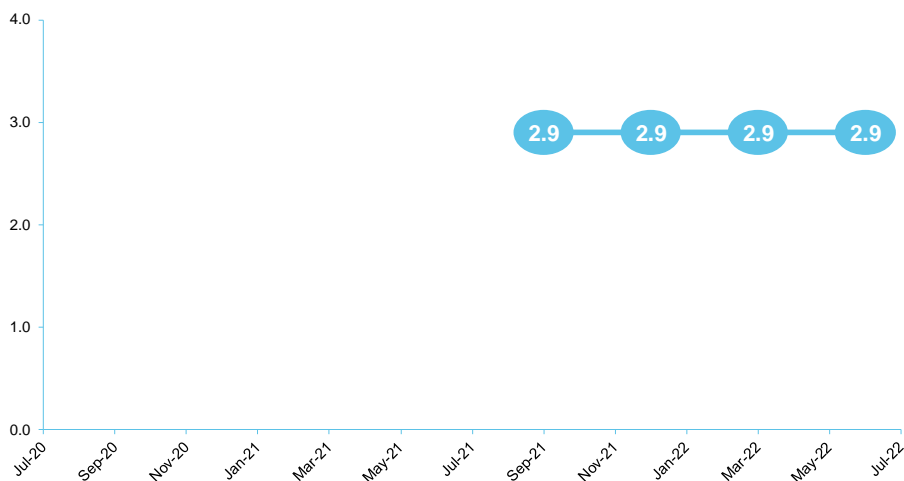
