Thai Union Group (TU TB)

Buy (Maintained)

Promising Long Run Despite Near-Term Costs; BUY

Target Price (Return): THB26.00 (38.3%)
Price (Market Cap): THB18.80 (USD2,615m)
ESG score: 3.40 (out of 4)
Avg Daily Turnover (THB/USD) 517m/15.7m

Keep BUY, new THB26.00 TP from THB27.00, 38% upside with c.4% FY22F yield. Thai Union Group's revenues should be solid, given the recoveries seen in many economies globally. We think its well-diversified businesses, innovative products, and cost-management initiatives will enable TU to have a better long-term view on future consumer trends.

• Oil price surge may increase transportation costs. The Russia-Ukraine war is likely to affect oil prices and transportation costs. Therefore, we revise down core profit by 4% to THB7.5bn (+3.2% YoY) as we increase SG&A/sales to 12.4% from our original estimate of 11.4%.

- Tuna costs are in a manageable range. Tuna costs increased to USD1,650/tonne (+3% MoM) in early March, which was lower after staying high at USD1,750/tonne during year-end 2021 this was on temporary weather volatility that reduced catches. Prices are expected to remain manageable at <USD2,000/tonne. TU still has a cushion against this, as it has cheap inventory in stock. The group is also able to adjust selling prices to reflect costs. Meanwhile, demand is improving in the US, EU, and Asia due to the economic recoveries there this has given TU the opportunity to adjust product prices. As most food manufacturers have also raised prices, this provides the group with a cushion to increase prices too. Note: TU also develops many high value-added products eg supplements and health foods to capture future customer demand.
- Attractive view ahead with plans to debut the pet care unit. TU is expected to post a solid 1Q22 performance due to the recoveries in the food and restaurant markets. In addition, the group plans to list its pet care business I-Tail Corp (ITC) on the stock market in 3Q22. TU plans to sell not more than 660m ITC shares, which should be allocated as: i) New share issuances of 600m shares and ii) the sale of 60m of its original stake in the firm. Post IPO, TU's holdings in ITC will represent 77.64% of the paid-up capital. The group's shareholders will also have pre-emptive rights to buy ITC shares relative to their stakes in TU (not more than 20% of ITC's IPO shares). The group's stake will then consist of the hidden value of its premium pet care business.
- Assigning ESG into valuations. TU has become a successful player in applying ESG principles when developing sustainable operations. Based on our in-house proprietary methodology, we derive an ESG score of 3.4. Accordingly, we apply a 2% premium to our DCF intrinsic value. The latter has been down to THB25.00 from the aforementioned profit revision. After applying our ESG methodology, we arrive at a new THB26.00 TP. BUY.
- Downside risks: Raw material volatilities and disease outbreaks/pandemics impacting demand.

Being reliant on seafood product and fishermen suppliers, TU has the highest exposure to this ESG pillar. However, it has managed its social and community relationships well. The company has a strong policy of not supporting labour malpractice suppliers. TU also applies international standards — as per those specified by Dow Jones Sustainability Indices and United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. It also conducts its social responsibility activities based on engaging in projects that are suitable for society needs.

G: EXCELLENT

TU follows the guidance of the Thai Institute of Directors. Its disclosure policy is in compliance with regulations set by the SET. As it is a listed company, TU also discloses important information broadly and promptly to stakeholders.


